

General rules, Terms & Conditions for Campers 2018

(Accepted by parent at Registration of Camper)

As every Camper displays their best behaviour, everyone will have an amazing time at iDestiny!

General, No-compromise guidelines for all campers, volunteers and staff:

- No hate speech or violence.
- No weapons of any kind.
- No alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- Entering rooms and ablution areas of opposite gender strictly prohibited.
- Every camper is treated as a young adult and facilitated to making own responsible decisions and choices. Bearing the consequences of our decisions is thus taught to every camper.

Terms and Conditions

- All parents / guardians are requested to read and explain to their children these terms and conditions as set out below.
- **Any and all teenagers are welcome** on the iDestiny camps, from any culture, any religion and any persuasion.
- **The language spoken at camp is English**, so fluent comprehension is a pre-requisite. By accepting this Terms and Conditions you confirm your child's adequate language skills.
- By accepting this Terms and Conditions, parent / guardian confirms that his/her child has permission **to participate in all camp programs**, camp trips, and special outings.
- By accepting this Terms and Conditions, parent / guardian confirms his/her acceptance that his/her **child may be pictured/photographed and that such material may be used by iDestiny for promotion or marketing on social media, flyers, video's and other media.**
- The copyright of all photography appearing on our brochures, social media or websites belongs to iDestiny. No reproduction may be made without prior permission from the iDestiny management.
- In the event that parent / guardian cannot be reached in an emergency when child is under iDestiny supervision, by accepting this Terms and Condition, the parent / guardian gives permission to the physician selected by the camp to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and/or order injections, anaesthesia, or surgery for the child as needed.
- All prescription medicine provided by a licensed Doctor must be turned into the camp staff upon arrival with instructions in English. This will be dispensed by camp staff only.
- All your child's personal belongings are their own responsibility. Expensive and treasured items such as jewellery, designer clothes or shoes, trainers, etc., should not be brought to the camp. **(see note on MOBILE PHONES below)**
- Electronic equipment, including but not limited to computers, TVs and video games are NOT allowed at camp, **WITH THE SOLE EXCEPTION OF ONE (1) MOBILE PHONE per camper**, which will **be handed in to iDestiny staff upon arrival at Camp Unity, photographed with owner**, handed in and stored, and then allocated at certain pre-determined breaks. **Every camper will sign their mobile phone IN and OUT at every cell phone break, with their Camp Facilitator, under iDestiny supervision.**

- All children at IDestiny are prohibited from bringing or using all tobacco products, alcohol, drugs OR WEAPONS of any kind.
- By accepting this Terms and Conditions, parent / guardian confirms his/her acceptance that IDestiny cannot be held liable, whether as a direct or indirect result of their or their helpers, volunteers or staff's actions or omissions or for any damage or loss to any Camper's mobile cell phone on or off IDestiny's camp premises. The Camper & camper's parent/guardian hereby indemnifies IDestiny against any liability as set out herein in full.
- **Payment**
IDestiny accepts the following methods of payment: cash and bank transfers (electronic funds transfer-EFT). Full payment must be received by us a minimum of one (1) week prior to the camp start date, with proof of payment received at admin@idestiny.org.za
- **Public Liability**
IDestiny does not and will not accept or admit any liability, whether as a direct or indirect result of their or their helpers, volunteers or staff's actions or omissions or for any damage, harm and/ or injury to any Camper or guest or any other visitor on or off IDestiny's camp premises, occurring before, during or after any period of stay at IDestiny's premises including any transport whether paid for or offered free of charge. The Camper and camper's parents / guardian hereby indemnifies IDestiny against any liability as set out herein in full.
- Parent / guardians agree to support IDestiny Program by encouraging children to abide by the highest standards of positive conduct. They will discuss constructive concerns, if any, regarding IDestiny Program, counselor or staff behavior or company policies with IDestiny management.
- Parent / guardians agree to pay for property damage caused directly, or indirectly, as a result of negligent action of their child.
